## **Description of Work**

## **Conditions**

The following shall be deemed to be conditions to the issuance of every permit under By-Law No. 4892.

- 5.3.1 Marking of Trees Unless otherwise exempted by permit, seven (7) days prior to injuring or destroying any tree the owner shall cause all trees which are to be removed or destroyed to be marked by a Registered Professional Forester with clearly visible marks of yellow paint at breast height and upon the stump to remain after cutting.
- 5.3.2 Notice of Intent for at least seven (7) days prior to injuring or destroying any trees the owner shall post a sign, having dimensions of not less than 28 cm. (11in.) x 43 cm. (17in.) in a conspicuous place on the private land that is adjacent to a public road or at such other location designated by the Town and providing the following information:
- 5.3.2.1 Notice that the work will occur in accordance with By-Law No. 4892;
- 5.3.2.2 The name of the land owner and agent;
- 5.3.2.3 The name of the person or company retained to work on the trees on the land; and
- 5.3.2.4 Name of the Department or Town Contact from whom further information can be obtained.
