

- Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday from 8 am - 4:30 pm
- Saturday from 8 am 12 pm
- If a holiday falls on a Monday, the Landfill will be closed on the following Tuesday. Check perth.ca/landfill for holiday closures.

Calendar Inside!

- Make sure your recycling, waste, and organics are at the curb by 7am on collection day!
- Only bagged, tied, and tagged household garbage will be accepted for pickup.
- Large items must be brought to the Landfill for disposal.
 Tipping fees will apply.
- Leaves, yard waste, and compost can be dropped off at the Landfill during operating hours for free!



Curbside Chronicles

What goes in the bin?



Green Bin

- Any type of food waste meat, bones, dairy, vegetables, fruits, breads, nuts, sauces, egg shells, expired foods, etc.
- Soiled paper products paper towels, tissues, pizza boxes, coffee filters, tea bags
- Wood toothpicks, popsicle sticks, skewers, sawdust, etc.
- Greenery household plants
- Pet waste and cat litter (must be in a paper bag or wrapped in newspaper)
- Floor sweepings
- Hair (human and pet)
- Dryer lint
- Ashes





- Medical waste
- Brush & yard waste
- Grass clippings
- Motor oil
- · Any plastic or metal

Keep your bin cleaner and in a fresher state!

- Spray bin with cooking spray to keep waste from sticking
- Sprinkle baking powder inside to reduce smells
- Freeze high odour items like food scraps then place them in the bin right before collection day
- Use plenty of newspaper or 100% paper to line your bin in layers
- Store your green bin out of the sun

Absolutely no plastics, including bio-degradable or compostable bags



Yellow Box

- Plastics #1, #2, #5 and #6 (excluding #6 polystyrene)
- Food and beverage jars
- Aluminum pop cans
- · Steel food cans
- Aluminum foil and trays
- Gable top and Tetra Pak cartons
 includes milk and juice cartons, drinking boxes, and spiral bound containers





- Styrofoam of any kind
- Plastic bags or plastic film
- Coffee cups
- Plant pots
- Toys



Blue Box

- Paper newspapers, magazines, and telephone books
- Boxboard cereal and other food boxes, tissue boxes, etc.
- Paper towel and toilet paper rolls
- Cardboard (flattened and bundled)
- Pizza boxes (clean)
- Books (remove covers first)
